This is SS24. Feminine. Raw. Sophisticated.










# CAPSULE 2

### **INGREDIENTS**

- · 2.5kg of fresh blue mussels
- 100g butter
- 3 diced red chillies
- 400g diced shallots
- 6 cloves of garlic
- 3 tbsp fresh thyme, roughly chopped
- · 8 tbsp broad-leaved parsley, coarsely chopped
- 350ml dry white wine
- salt/pepper
- 250ml cream
- 600g fries
- 1.5 litres rapeseed oil

### **HOW TO**

Lightly tap blue mussels on the kitchen counter, discarding those that do not close. Rinse well. Melt butter and fry onion and chilli, removing from the heat before they colour. Add herbs and stir, before adding white wine and cook until reduced by half. Add cream and season with salt and pepper. Add mussels and let them steam under the lid for 8 -10 minutes, stirring a few times. Cook fries in heated oil and fry for approximately 8 minutes.

Serve mussels between four deep plates and serve with fries.

# Salmon tartare with rhubarb

### **INGREDIENTS**

- 300g smoked salmon
- 50g field lettuce
- 4 spring onions cut into small rings
- radish sprouts (garnish)

### Pickled rhubarb:

- 200g rhubarb in small pieces
- 150ml water
- 3 tbsp sugar
- 3 tbsp apple cider vinegar
- juice of 1 lime

## Egg yolk cream:

- 50g good quality mayonnaise
- 25g egg yolk
- 1 tsp apple cider vinegar
- salt/pepper

### Pickled rhubarb:

Bring water, sugar, lime juice/peel and vinegar to the boil. Add rhubarb to the stock and boil for 15 seconds. Remove the rhubarb from the sheet and refrigerate both parts.

### Egg yolk cream:

Whisk mayonnaise, egg yolk, vinegar, salt and pepper well together.

Distribute the lettuce on four plates, sprinkle with spring onions, distribute the rhubarb, and drizzle with a little brine. Divide salmon into small pieces and add drops of egg yolk cream. Garnish with radish sprouts.












# Handmade Jewelry FROM DENMARK



"My name is Lise Reo, founder of Libopé Jewels. The name 'Libopé' is taken from my maiden name, Lise Boje Pedersen." I started my first jewellery business, Sorelle Jewellery, in 2009. After running it successfully for ten years, I chose to take a step back and pass the business on to new owners. Sorelle had grown so large I couldn't manage It alone. The decision wasn't easy, and I questioned myself many times. But looking back, it was the right thing for me to do. I live in Randers, Denmark with my husband and our two children, Jack and Amy and I work part-time in finance. However, when I sold Sorelle, I realised that something was missing in my life. I felt a real creative void. I still wanted to make jewellery, but needed to do so in a way that worked for me; with a new concept.



That's why I decided to start Libopé Jewels. It's more than just a hobby, it's my therapy and the outlet for all my creative expression.

All the jewellery I make is a limited edition, meaning that no two pieces are the same. Sometimes I make one piece of a single design, or sometimes more, but they are always unique. If I'm drawn to a particularly special pearl or stone, I will save it for a one-off piece of jewellery.

Stones and pearls are my true love, and the fact that each one is different means I can continually evolve my designs and still produce in small quantities. That's what I love most about jewellery making, it's truly personal. As Libopé isn't my full time job, there can be periods

when I make more or less jewellery, depending on my free time and motivation.

I made a deliberate choice to keep production runs small and limited. Because of that, it's important that my clients act fast when they find a piece of jewellery they love; they don't stick around for long! I adore the process of selecting materials and sourcing the perfect pearls and stones; to me, it's as important as the making.

The description of each piece is important to me which is why I take time to tell the story of each design. I go into detail about the background and materials of the jewellery, as for me this is key to the process.





#### **WAYS TO WEAR** THE GREY DRESS














# andwich

#### **INGREDIENTS**

6 brioche buns

- 450 g shrimp
- 100 g smoked salmon
- 3 avocados
- 50 g garlic sprouts

#### Herb Aioli:

- 2 egg yolks
- 1 tablespoon apple cider vinegar
- 1 tsp. Dijon mustard
- 1 teaspoon lemon juice
- 2 1/2 dl taste neutral oil
- 5 gr. fresh oregano
- 15 g thyme
- 40 gr. chive leaves
- Salt/pepper

#### Red onion chutney:

- 30 grams of butter
- 300 g. red onion, diced
- 3 tablespoons brown sugar
- 1 dl. beer
- 1 red chili finely diced
- 6 tablespoons red balsamic vinegar

#### **HOW TO**

Herb aioli:

Blend herbs and oil until smooth.
Whisk egg yolks, apple cider vinegar,
Dijon mustard, lemon and salt and
pepper until fluffy. Add the herb oil
and hand blend until the aioli is thick.

#### Red onion chutney:

Melt butter and lightly fry onion and chilli. Add sugar and once melted, add beer and cook until thickened. Add balsamic vinegar to taste.

Spread the buns with aioli. Layer with prawns and avocado, before laying salmon on top. Add a good spoonful of onion chutney on each and garnish with garlic sprouts.
